Your fingers can help you remember what to pray for

You use your index finger to point with. Let it remind you to pray for teachers, pastors, parents, and others who point you in the right direction.

Your middle finger is the tallest finger. This finger reminds us to pray for the leaders of our nation and our world.

The ring finger is our weakest finger. Let your ring finger remind you to pray for people who need help.

The last finger is your pinkie. Let your pinkie remind you to pray for yourself, asking God to help guide you as you live your life and try to do what God wants you to do.
